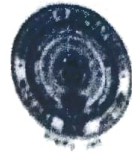

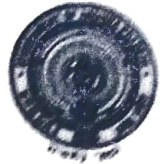

Police, the world over, has adapted itself to meet the changing requirements of Safety and Security of Public life and property. With the changing technology, there has been a demand on Police to introduce new and specialized wings from time to time ranging from mere Law and Order Police Stations to Central Crime Stations to Traffic Police Stations on one hand and new Special Police Organizations from CID, Railways to Grey Hounds and Octopus etc.

One such functional requirement is Road Safety which includes Traffic Planning and Highway Patrolling. About 1,20,000 people died in road accidents in the country in 2010. It is estimated that the country loses about 3% of its GDP because of road accidents. In the year 2010 while 2305 precious lives were lost under the head of "Murder", as many as 15,696 precious lives were lost in road accidents, in the State of Andhra Pradesh alone. This figure is rising at a rate of 10% every year

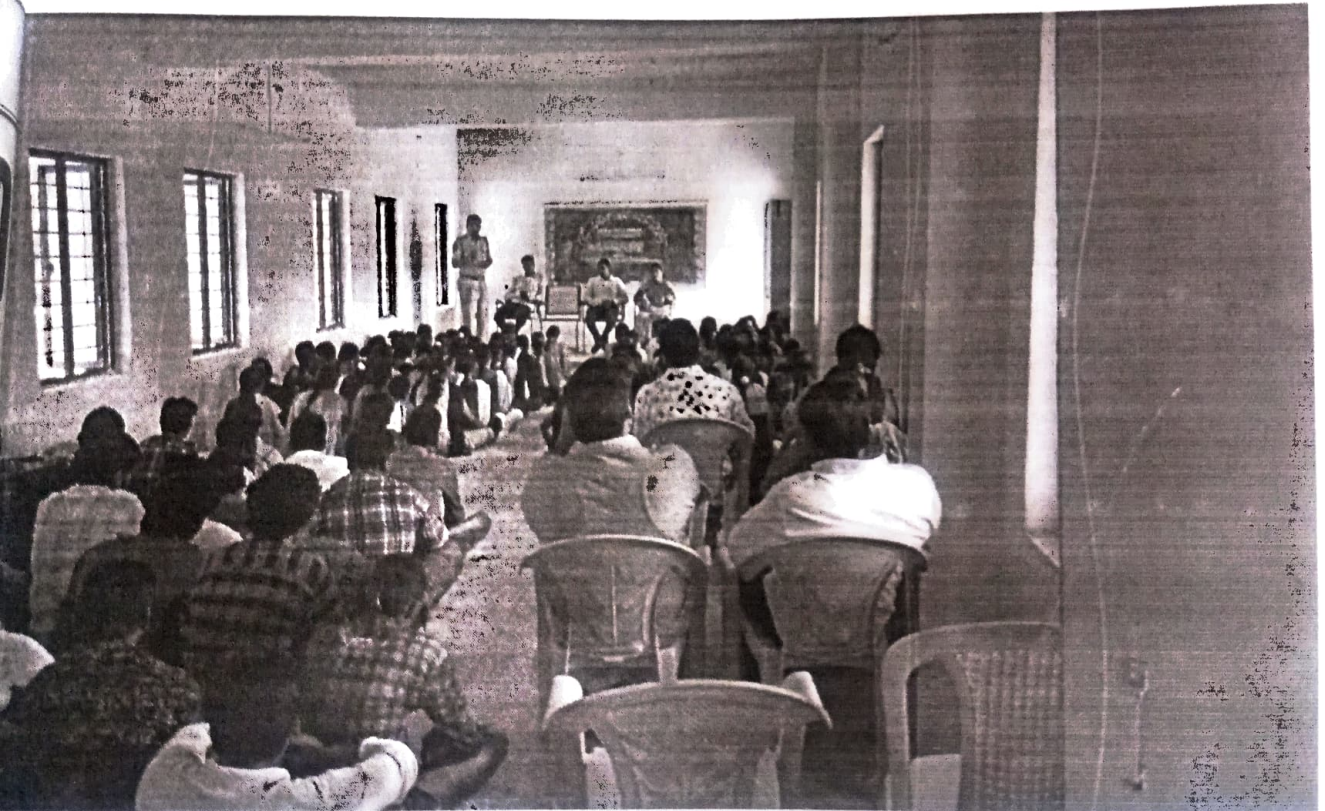
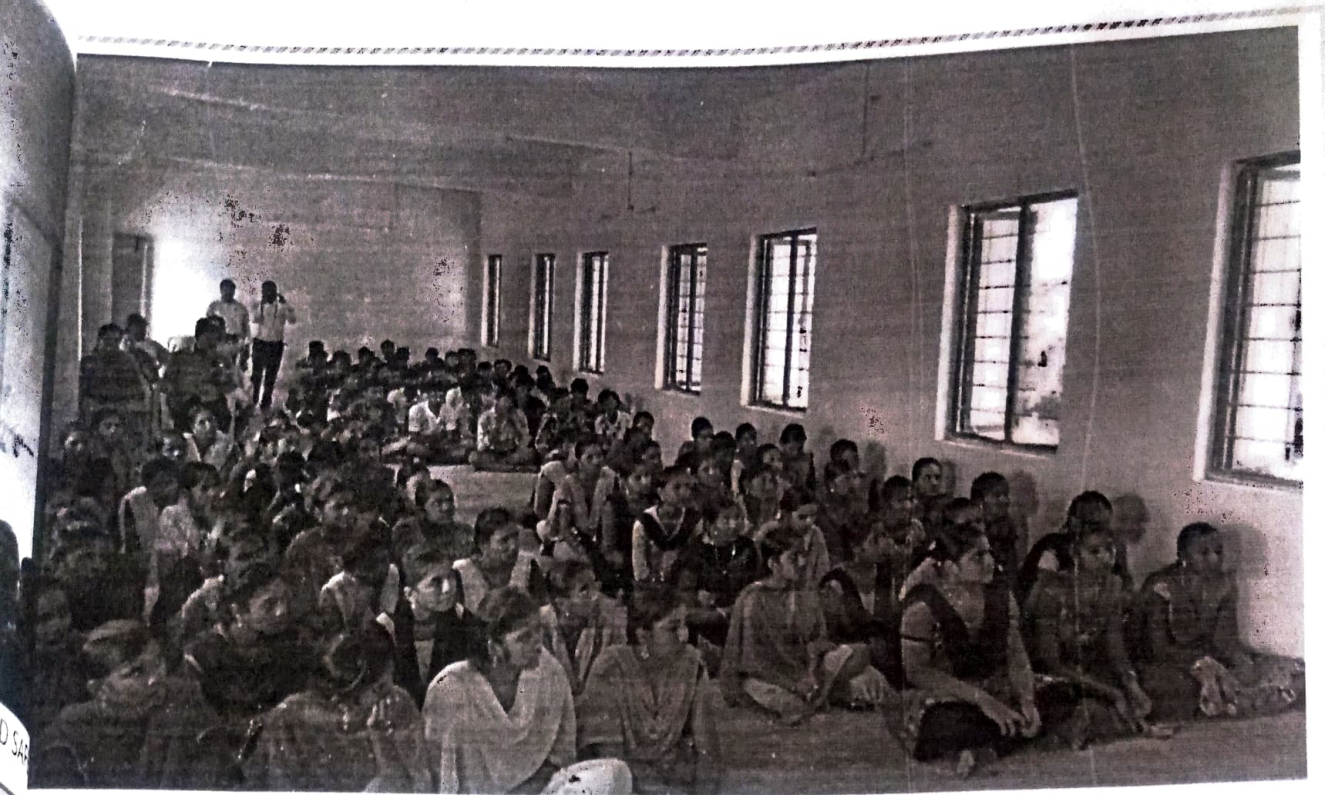

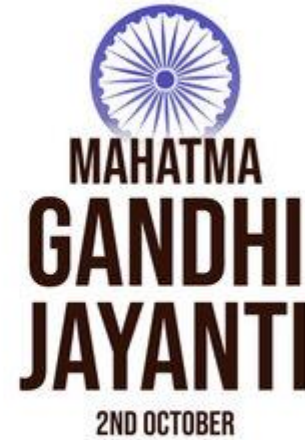

GANDHI JAYANTI 2 OCTOBER- 2018

Brief History

The clarion call of Mahatma Gandhi to free our country from the clutches of British rule was gaining momentum throughout the country. Seethanagaram, a small village in East Godavari District of Andhra Pradesh exhibited a very good patriotic spirit in the non-co-operation movement. Inspired by this fervor for freedom struggle, veteran freedom fighter this Dr. BRAHMA JYOTSULA SUBRAHMANYAM Garu grounded Gowthami satyagraha Ashram on 9th Nov.1924. The foundation stone for the Ashram was laid by Sri Bulusu Sambamurthy Garu. This Ashram became a nucleus hub for Freedom Movement. GANDHIJI visited this Ashram on two occasions and stayed for more than three days. The place where Bapuji along with Kasturba stayed has been aptly named as BAPU KUTTER, which even today stands as a testimony to their visit.

After the demise of Kasturba Gandhi at Aga khan palace, Pune, under detention in 1944, the Kasturba Gandhi National Memorial Trust was established in 1945 under the Chairmanship of Mahatma Gandhi with its headquarters in Kasturbagram, Indore, M.P. Gandhiji wished that this Trust should work for the upliftment of women and children in rural India. The Trust established 22 State branches all over the Country. Due to this SeethanagaramAsharam became a park of Kasturba Gandhi National Memorial Trust encompassing all properties and activities.

Disaster management refers to the conservation of lives and property during natural or human-made disasters. Disaster management plans are multi-layered and are planned to address issues such as floods, hurricanes, fires, mass failure of utilities, the rapid spread of disease, and droughts. India is especially vulnerable to natural disasters because of its unique geo-climatic condition, having recurrent floods, droughts, cyclones, earthquakes, and landslides. As India is a very large country, different regions are vulnerable to different natural disasters. For example, during the rainy season, the peninsular regions of South India are mostly affected by cyclones, and states of West India experience severe drought during the summer season.

First aid refers **to the emergency or immediate care you should provide when a person is injured or ill until full medical treatment is available.** For minor conditions, first aid care may be enough. ... The decision to act appropriately with first aid can mean the difference between life and death.

Awareness program on H1N1 by Health Dept on 21-Nov-2018

Swine influenza is an infection caused by any one of several types of swine influenza viruses. **Swine influenza virus (SIV)** or **swine-origin influenza virus (S-OIV)** is any strain of the influenza family of viruses that is endemic in pigs. As of 2009, the known SIV strains include influenza C and the subtypes of influenza A known as H1N1, H1N2, H2N1, H3N1, H3N2, and H2N3.

Swine influenza virus is common throughout pig populations worldwide. Transmission of the virus from pigs to humans is not common and does not always lead to human flu, often resulting only in the production of antibodies in the blood. If transmission does cause human flu, it is called zoonotic swine flu. People with regular exposure to pigs are at increased risk of swine flu infection.

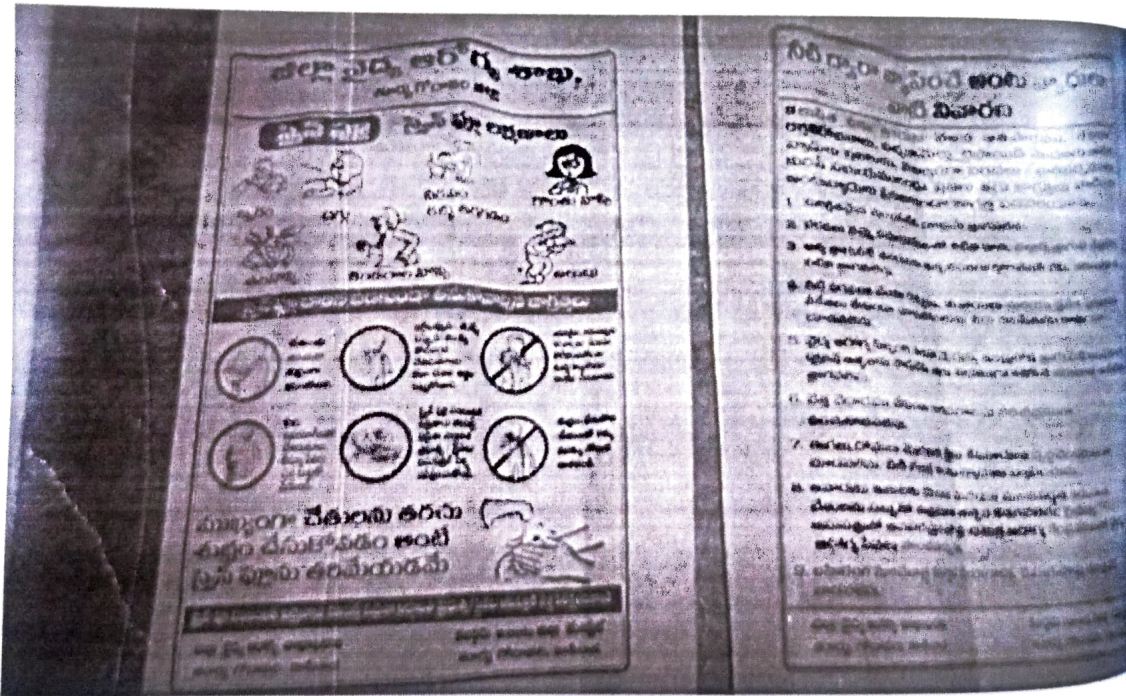
Around the mid-20th century, identification of influenza subtypes became possible, allowing accurate diagnosis of transmission to humans. Since then, only 50 such transmissions have been confirmed. These strains of swine flu rarely pass from human to human. Symptoms of zoonotic swine flu in humans are similar to those of influenza and of influenza-like illness in general, namely chills, fever, sore throat, muscle pains, severe headache, coughing, weakness, shortness of breath, and general discomfort.

It is estimated that in the 2009 flu pandemic 11–21% of the then global population (of about 6.8 billion), or around 700 million to 1.4 billion people, contracted the illness—more in absolute terms than the Spanish flu pandemic. There were 18,449 confirmed fatalities. However, in a 2012 study, the CDC estimated more than 284,000 possible fatalities worldwide, with a range from 150,000 to 575,000. ^{[3][4]} In August 2010, the World Health Organization declared the swine flu pandemic officially over.

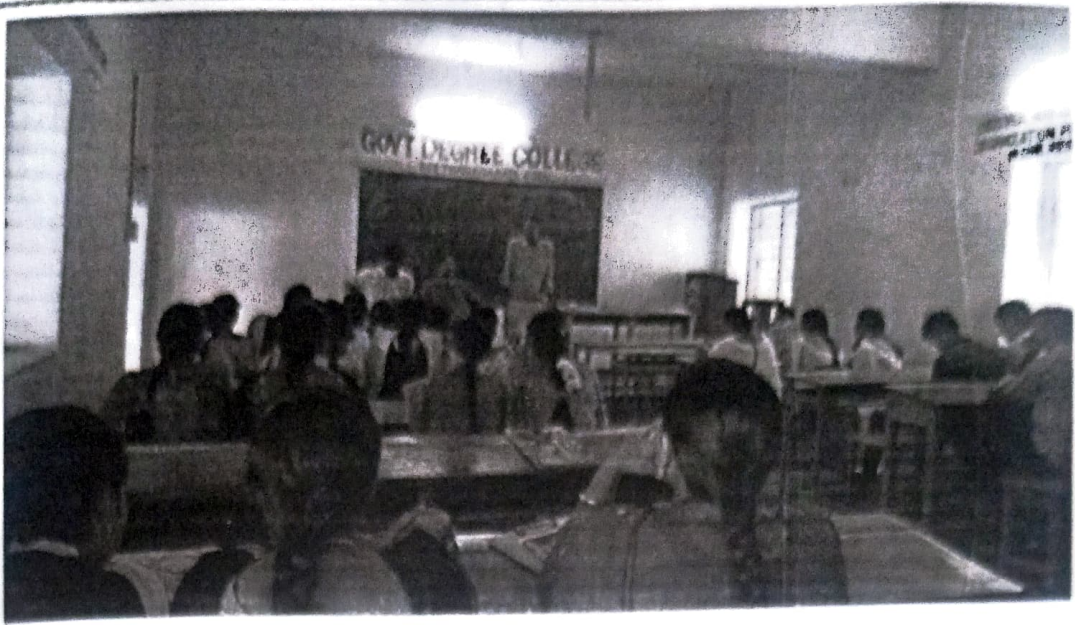

World Human Rights Day

Human Rights Day is celebrated annually across the world on 10 December every year.

The date was chosen to honour the United Nations General Assembly's adoption and proclamation, on 10 December 1948, of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR), the first global enunciation of human rights and one of the first major achievements of the new United Nations. The formal establishment of Human Rights Day occurred at the 317th Plenary Meeting of the General Assembly on 4 December 1950, when the General Assembly declared resolution 423(V), inviting all member states and any other interested organizations to celebrate the day as they saw fit.

The day is normally marked both by high-level political conferences and meetings and by cultural events and exhibitions dealing with human rights issues. Besides, it is traditionally on 10 December that the five-yearly United Nations Prize in the Field of Human Rights and Nobel Peace Prize is awarded. Many governmental and non-governmental organizations active in the human rights field also schedule special events to commemorate the day, as do many civil and social-cause organisations.

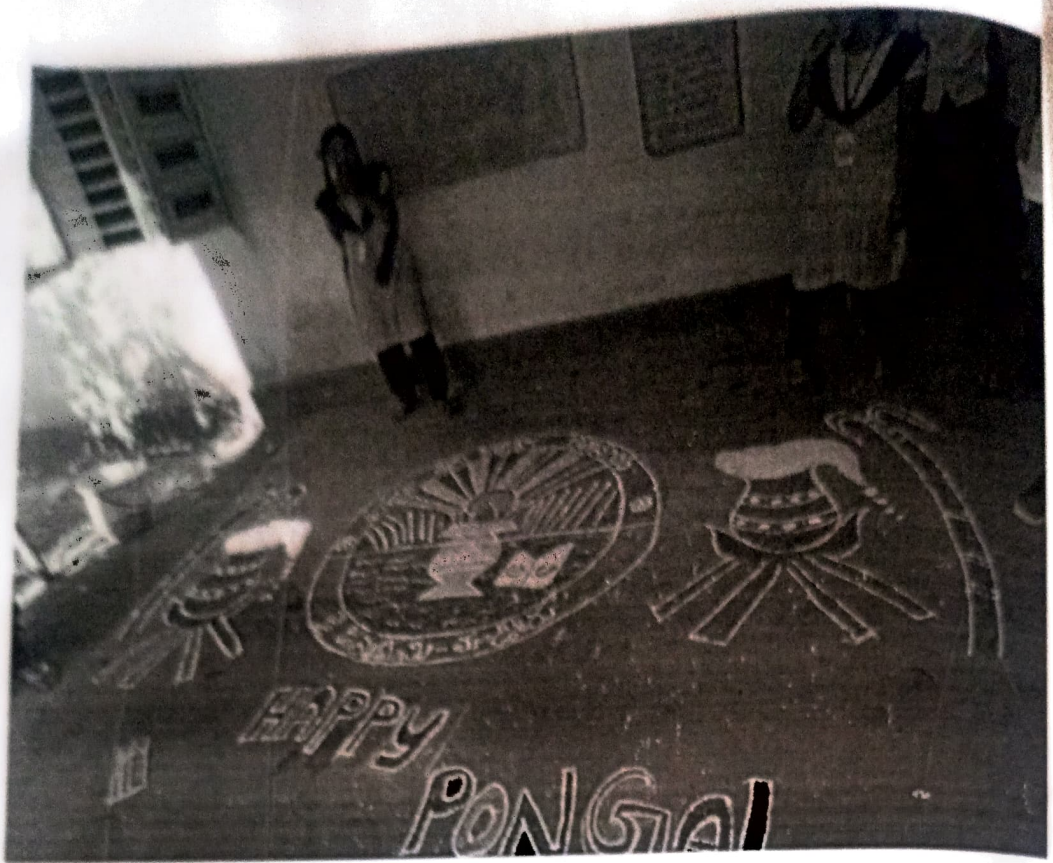

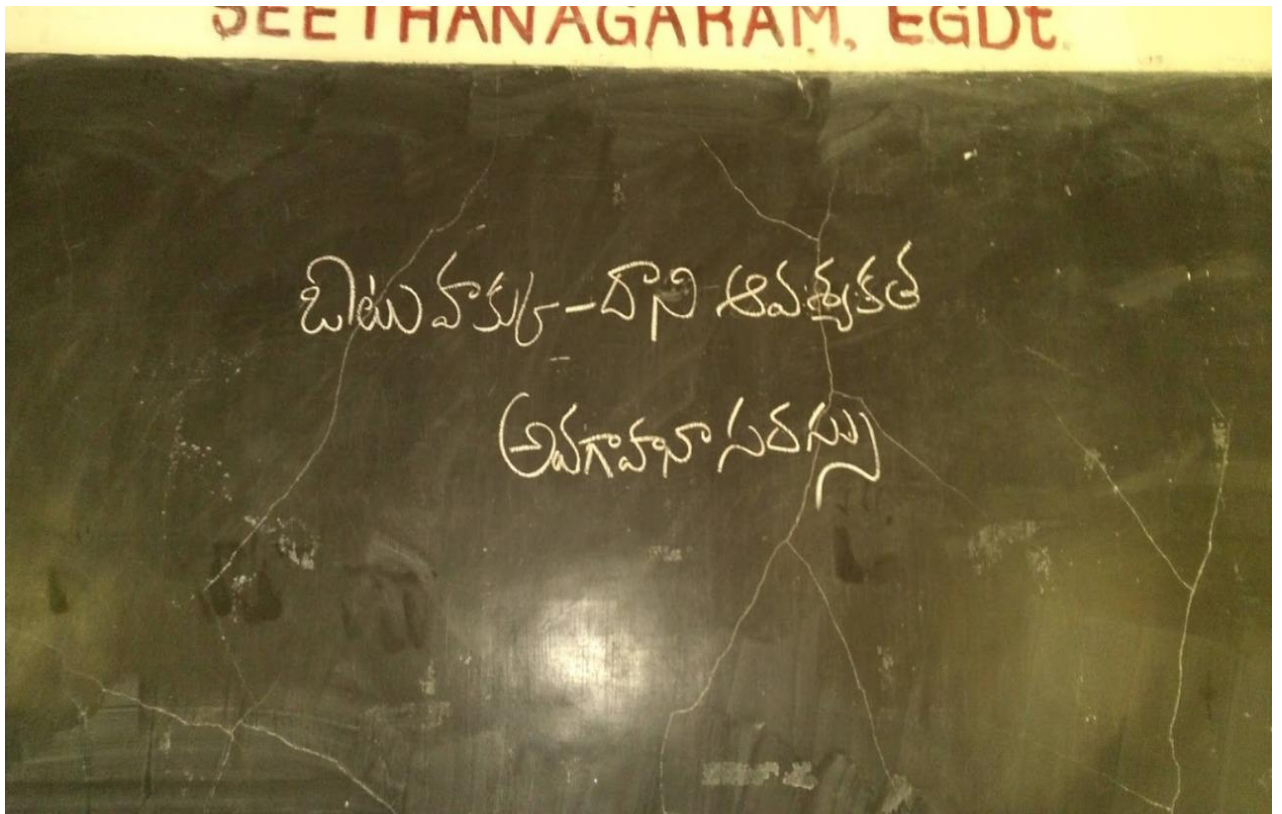
Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation

POLAVARAM PROJECT VISIT ON 08-02-2019

The IQAC and all the departments in the college organized a field trip to Polavaram National Project on 08-02-2019 with the financial Assistance of the Andhra Pradesh Irrigation Department, Rajamundry.

Objectives of the Field Trip:

- To deepen Social and Historical Knowledge among the students
- To develop Critical Thinking Skills among the students.
- To highlight Career Opportunities
- To promote Interest in Art and Culture
- To provide valuable qualitative and affective learning experiences which will encourage deeper thinking about the interaction between man and his environment.
- To train art students in observation skills through drawings.
- To create an appreciation of nature in art students.
- To be exposed to the cultures and way of life of different groups of people and to be humble and respectful of their interaction.

Description of the Field Trip

The IQAC and the departments of Arts, Commerce, and Science planned a field trip to Polavaram National Water Project which is being constructed in Polavaram, West Godavari District. The Irrigation Department of East Godavari district arranged two APSRTC buses for the students and the staff to visit the project. The Project is located 40 km away from the college. 80 students from all the programs and 10 members of the staff participated in the field trip.
